Margaret H Pilkington had a lifelong interest in the out of doors and the training of young people. This bursary fund has been set up in her memory and is a fitting tribute to her.

This Training Bursary fund is open to members of Girlguiding Merseyside & Girlguiding Sefton who are 15 years or over.

The bursary is available for activities or trainings organised by Girlguiding UK, or other recognised body, acceptable to the committee. Preference will be given to adults attending courses, which lead to a qualification for the benefit of girls and young women. Grants may be awarded for camp & pack holidays trainings leading to a qualification, archery, canoeing, Queen's Guide expeditions.

Application must be signed by your District or Division Commissioner and sent to the Secretary, for consideration by the committee, **at least six weeks before the course or event begins.**

HINTS & TIPS FOR A SUCCESSFUL APPLICATION

- Upon receipt & completion of your application form, check that you have completed all parts of the form.
- It helps to include a sheet detailing as much information as possible e.g. what type of course/event you are attending, which body is running the course/event, along with how you think it will benefit yourself and/or the girls.
- Lastly, outline the total cost of event/course, how much you are paying personally or have raised so far, or any fundraising plans you may have.
